To be eligible for a Bruce Power Early Childhood Education Scholarship, you must:

- Be registered in the Early Childhood Education program, or Advanced ECE program.
- Submit a short essay (250 words) indicating why you want to be a Registered ECE and work in Bruce County.
- Provide proof of registration.

TUITION GRANTS FROM THE COUNTY OF BRUCE AND ONTARIO ECE GRANTS ARE ALSO AVAILABLE. THERE IS ALSO AN OPTION FOR COURSE EXEMPTIONS (PLAR PROGRAM).

Bruce County residents can receive up to \$2,000 in funding.

Students with a related diploma, degree or work experience can apply to **fast-track** their course completion. Students can also apply to be **exempt from course placement requirements** if they are currently working in a licensed childcare program or have experience that meets the program's placement.

Scholarships will be awarded by October 31, 2026.
