

New provincial COVID-19 Screening Tool implemented at Bruce Power entrances

Bruce Power, and all employers across the province, are now required by law to use a COVID-19 Screening Tool provided by the Ontario government.

We understand this new process caused significant delays at site entrances this morning and we apologize for the inconvenience. We have since simplified the process to adhere to the new screening requirements. This new process will take effect tomorrow morning.

The new provincial screening tool requirements now consists of [screening questions](#) that everyone must ask themselves prior to entering site and/or a Bruce Power off-site building. We will have these screening questions posted at all site access entrances and off-site building entrances.

Security will continue to ask everyone the following two questions:

- Are you experiencing any COVID symptoms?
- Is there any reason why you should be self-isolating?

The expectation is that you have familiarized yourself with the new screening questions to help us streamline the process for site access. This new COVID screening will also be a focus of VMBs next week.

Our COVID-19 response has been evolving since March as we have implemented several precautionary measures, working with the Ontario Government, the Grey Bruce Health Unit and Medical Officer of Health, Dr. Ian Arra.

As numbers continue to rise across Ontario, it is important we strictly adhere to all protocols and precautions put in place to keep everyone safe.

To help alleviate congestion, staff are encouraged to use the North concession entrance while South concession undergoes paving this week.
